


“The Picture of Health” is an

educational program intended to present an overview of radiologic imaging and identification of pathologic conditions seen on plain films, CT scans and MRIs.

PowerPoint presentations will use the anatomical comparative illustrations to facilitate identification of radiologic features. The curriculum is tailored for medical practitioners to enhance their knowledge and advance their skills in evaluating a variety of conditions using radiologic diagnostics. The material is targeted toward registered nurses, nurse practitioners, physician assistants and paramedic level EMTs and other interested health care providers

This offering will introduce the medical care provider to a simplified approach to interpreting elected radiologic images. The student will be better prepared to identify a variety of pathologic conditions as presented by radiological imaging.

From Rte. 95/128:

Take EXIT 30B (Rte. 2A west). Follow Rte. 2A west for 2 miles, then follow signs for Hanscom Air Force Base. Turn right onto Hanscom Drive and proceed to the visitors center. Stop at the guard shack for a mandatory drivers license ID check by base security. Be sure to have your car registration with you. Allow extra time for check-in, expect delays. 
